



## Racha – The Facts

Ko Racha (also known as Ko Raya) consists of 2 islands Racha Yai and Racha Noi. The islands are situated only 18km south of Phuket and considering this close proximity they are relatively under exposed when comparing to the likes of Ko Phi Phi making it perfect for a private and relaxing day cruise away from the crowds.

The Racha islands are surrounded by crystal clear waters, whilst below the surface the numerous living coral reefs and hundreds of fish, meaning the islands provides some of Phuket's best swimming and snorkeling experiences.

Racha Yai is the more visited island for day-trippers with a few hotels and resorts including The Racha a 5\* resort. It houses numerous white sandy beaches including Siam Bay, and Ao Tawan Tok (bay). Bungalow Bay is a beautiful white sandy beach located within a large U-Shaped bay and with its crystal clear waters, ideal for swimming; it is easy to see why it is so popular.

Racha Noi is an uninhabited mainly rocky island with some beautifully secluded coves to moor the boat in. There is however 1 stunning beach located at the southern tip and when the tide is right a sand bar connecting it to a rocky outcrop which is a company favourite destination. Also around the island are some amazing coral reefs that are perfect for snorkeling.

There are also a number of other smaller islands between Phuket and Ko Racha such as Ko Hey (Coral Island) which again is another perfect opportunity for one last swim and snorkel in privacy.
